






How-To Guide

I. Creating Folders:

- a. To create a new folder tap the plus symbol (circle below). When the menu appears type the name of the folder.




II. Creating a New Note:

- a. To create a new note first tap the folder you would like the document in then tap the square with a pencil located in the top right corner. A new blank note will then open. You will be able to title and date stamp the document by tapping on the title or the date.




III. Loading Content:

- a. Option One: Email any PDF Document to the email address that is set up on your iPad. Then tap the document in the email to open a menu. Tap 'Open In...' and you can choose between the Apps that accept PDF documents. Tap on Notability. The document will then open up the Notability app and be downloaded into the app. If you would like the document in a specific folder, prior to opening the document in Notability open the notability app and click the folder you would like the document to download into. If you need to move the document simple hold your finger on the miniature picture of the document and drag to the appropriate folder.



- b. Option Two: Go to any website that allows you to download PDF documents to your computer and follow the same steps (i.e. SuperTeacherWorksheets.com, EdHelper.com or HaveFunTeaching.com). A separate tab will open with the document. Tap the document and a menu will appear asking where you would like to download the PDF document. Tap 'Open In...' and then tap Notability and the document will download. Follow the same steps for folder placement as Option One.



IV. Adding Content:

- Typing-** Add text to the document by tapping anywhere on the page. The typing cursor will appear and the keyboard will open.
- Pen-** Tap the pen and write with your finger or a stylus anywhere on the document. Tap and hold the pen button to open a menu where you can change the size and color of your pen.
- Highlighter-** Tap the highlighter and with your finger or stylus you can highlight any text within the document. Tap and hold the highlighter button to open a menu where you can change the size and color of your highlighter.
- Eraser-** Tap the eraser and scrub over anything you have added to the document and it will erase it. You can also undo and redo your work with the arrows next to the editing bar.
- Scissors-** Tap the scissors and use your finger to circle, square, or draw around anything you have added to the document to cut, move, or copy/paste.
- Plus Symbol-** Tap the Plus symbol to add content to the document. You can add a photo, web clip, text box, take a photo to add, figures, or handwriting to your document.

Animal Care Workers

Most people like animals, especially pets. It's fun to play with them, to train them, and, most of the time, to take care of them. But taking care of animals all the time can be hard work.

Animal care workers train, feed, water, groom, bathe, and exercise animals. They clean, disinfect, and repair their cages. They also play with the animals and look for changes that could mean illness or injury. There are many different kinds of jobs in animal care.



Kennel attendants usually care for pets like dogs and cats when their owners are out of town. They clean cages and dog runs, fill food and water dishes, and exercise the animals. Some kennels provide basic healthcare and grooming. Attendants may sell pet food and supplies and provide obedience training. Other kennels help with breeding.

Groomers may work in kennels, veterinary clinics or offices, animal shelters, or pet supply stores. Others may have their own offices, and make house calls! Groomers take care of the appearance of pets. They clip hair or fur, cut nails, clean ears, bathe, blow dry, and they often are the first to notice a medical problem such as a skin infection.

feeding, grooming, and exercising them. They are responsible for saddling and unsaddling the horses, giving them rubdowns, and walking them to cool off after a ride. They may also clean out stalls, polish saddles, organize the tack room, and order and store supplies and feed. Some groomers may help in training.

Zookeepers prepare the food for animals, clean their living areas, and sometimes help in raising the babies. They watch for signs of illness or injury. Keepers may also answer zoo visitors' questions. Some zookeepers work only with one kind of animal such as large cats; others work with a larger group such as reptiles.

Most animal care workers are trained on the job. There are some training programs for specific kinds of caretakers, such as groomers, but it is usually not required for beginning workers. Trainers usually need a high school diploma. Some areas, like training marine mammals, require a degree in biology, marine biology, zoology, or a similar field. All animal care workers need patience, dedication to the well-being of animals, and experience in solving problems.

V. Sharing Content:

- a. To share content from Notability tap the button in the top left corner that looks like a rectangle with an arrow coming out from the right side (hint: this share button is the same in almost every app). A menu will appear and it will give you the option to the 'Choose Destination' of your document (default is email). Tap on 'Email' to choose a different location. You can choose to have the document 'open in...' another app such as 'iBooks' to save for later reference. Once you select your destination you will be taken back to the previous menu.
