- A. Artificially break the act of teaching down into four simple "domains":
- 1. Routine tasks of communicating, exploring, and planning
- 2. Assigning work to students
- 3. Receiving work from students
- 4. Grading and returning feedback to students
- B. Identify your current practices and routines for each domain and then isolate or name current actions you find to be inefficient, unproductive, or time-consuming? (ex. I hate taking home 75 projects over the weekend OR, Using class time to hand essays back to students seems inefficient)
- C. How can the iPad, the 5 core Marist Apps and/or Schoology be used to simplify or improve a current practice?
- D. Ask yourself, "Will this new approach require new habits or routines? Is it actually simpler or an improvement, or am I more intrigued by the functionality and capacity of this new tool?"
